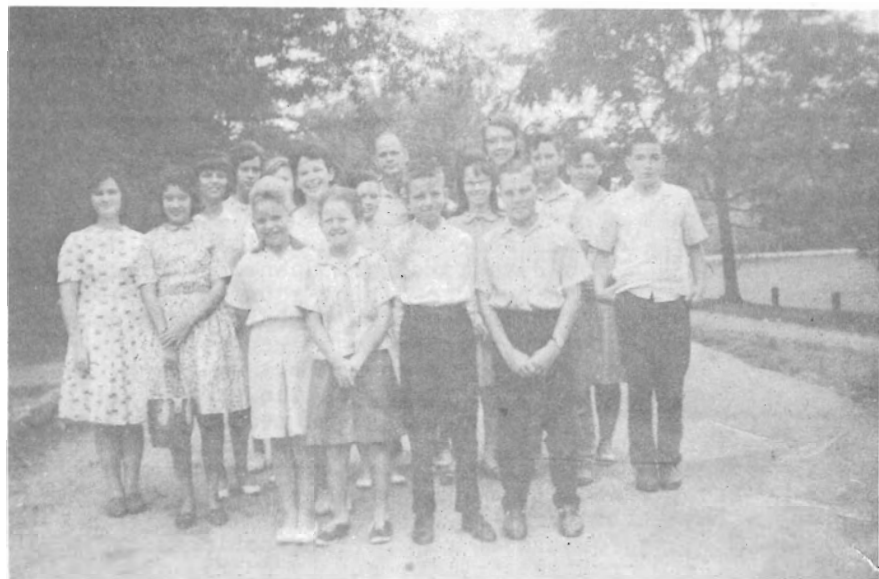

We should praise His name.

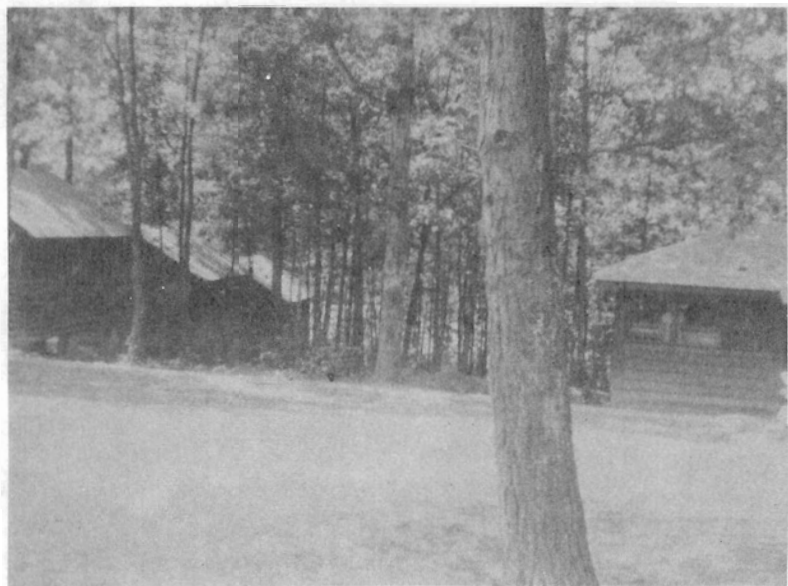
In this house where God's honor dwells,

And sing His holy praise.

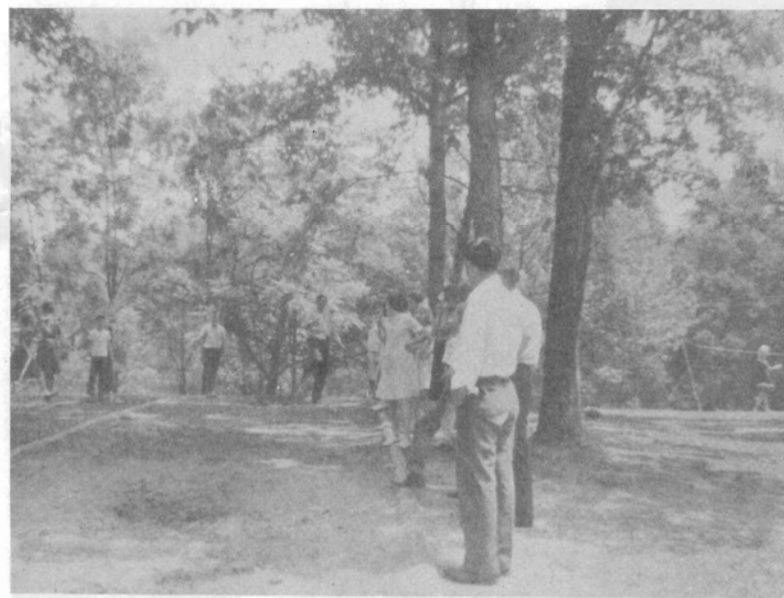
