ABI PRESIDENT & WIFE HONORED

The United Pentecostal Church Executives honored the outstanding pioneers of Pentecostal Christian Education, Rev. and Mrs. S. G. Norris. Founder and President of Apostolic Bible Institute in St. Paul, MN, Rev. and Mrs. Norris have committed their lives to exalting the Word of God. Their teaching and example have touched the lives of thousands across the world. Their contribution to Pentecost indeed merits their title - Mr. and Mrs. Pentecost!

"Time is too short and my abilities are far too limited to say the things that need to be said here today to pay the deserved honor to one of the most outstanding men of this generation, Rev. S. G. Norris. By his side is the equally deserving woman of beauty and strength, knowledge, and wisdom and Christian example, Jessie A. Norris. I feel humble but have the honor to be a small part of this brief contemplation of Mr. and Mrs. Pentecost.

Forty-three years ago, and this is quite a while ago, just fresh out of the world, I enrolled in the Apostolic Bible Institute in St. Paul, Minnesota. Brother Norris was in his prime - young and strong, handsome, forceful, persuasive and eloquent. He was a masterful preacher and teacher. He was and remains a man of profound, pronounced and positive conviction. This man of God and this godly woman molded my life and thousands of others sending us forth, initially equipped fulfilling a God-called ministry. The very necessary foundational and most important things I know, they taught me. What they taught me remains with me until even now. What they taught me was doctrinally, logically and historically sound. It was apostolic Bible sound - ABI. They gave me a love for the truth - this One God, Holy Ghost, tongue-talking, Jesus' Name, Apostolic, holy message that all of the devils in hell or out of hell, not even an angel in heaven can ever take from me. These two Apostolic champions in pioneering days, and I pause here to say - when Bible Schools were scoffed at - and Bible school students were scoffed at - dared to do the impossible. Years have vindicated them and their efforts. They are not scoffed at any more. Our two honorees have given to the United Pentecostal Church some of its best-trained men and women. It is not their fault

that I am nothing more than I am because they did their best with what they had to work with.

It is impossible to measure the value of a person that believes something with all of his heart and holds it against all odds and summons his followers, his pupils, his disciples, his officers to walk in truth, wherever it may lead or whatever it may cost. Brother Norris taught us that some things are unchangeably true and other things are just as unchangeably false. He said very repeatedly, "I hate every false way!" He had no fellowship with those who trifled with truth or defected to some false "ism". He taught us the same. He poured Apostolic truth into us and said with God, "I have no greater joy than that my children (my pupils) walk in truth". He taught us that the pulpit was no place for a spiritual stammerer. His was Paul's apostolic injunction - "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed but rightly dividing the word of truth". Know this book...believe it...teach it and live it! It was my darling Sister Norris who gave me evangelism. Brother Norris taught us Apostolic Old Testament, New Testament covenant excellently, but it was Sister Norris who got a few of us hardheads together. We knocked on doors and did personal evangelism. It was Sister Norris who imputed into my life, interjected into my soul, Sunday School. In eight and one-half years of evangelistic work that we did, everywhere we went, we broke the Sunday School record. That is one of the foundational truths that has helped me in our efforts. She went with us and taught us personal evangelism. It has proven to be excellent in my life. It has helped us to get where we are now. Our two honorees today are two glorious Christians, yet at the same time, very human. They never paraded their piety. They just lived it every day. One of

the greatest proofs of his greatness - I was in a Bible study one night (I love the Word of God) and I asked a question. I wanted to know if I knew it. He said, "Yes, you're telling me". He found me where I was in prayer - it was in the basement of 464 Pierce St.-and sat down and put his arms around me and said, "Forgive me". Brother Norris and I prayed many hours together in the prayer room. I was on a seven day fast and I hadn't eaten nor drunk anything. Brother Norris heard about it. He started looking for me. He finally found me and said, "Mangun, you can't starve to death. You've got to come off that fast". You see, I learned those things there. I thank God for it. Brother Norris magnified his office. His very person displayed godly authority. Brother Norris - because of your marvelous gifts - wisdom and knowledge - you are both valiant and steel. He has wholesome wit and Christian humor and love for the Apostolic faith. We weep that you would ever weaken physically. I think that if it were possible, I would give to you what strength I have so that you could continue your great and noble work. But I will pledge myself to the Apostolic truths that you so capably and ably taught me. I will continue to pour into others all that you poured into me. I will walk in your paths and together we will continue all that you began to do and teach.

I shall always be grateful for these two people: for the ministry of the Word and the ministry of evangelism which have been the greatest part of my life. Thank you, Brother and Sister Norris.



THE WAR IN THE SKY

Sermon preached by Rev. S. G. Norris, November 20, 1983

Turn to the book of Daniel. I am going to speak, by the help of the Lord, on the topic - What is Going On Above Us in the Heavens...beyond the sun, the stars, and the moon. There is a terrific battle going on between the angels of God and the devil and his angels which we hear very little about. But it may be the most important truth to know in order to help us keep from being discouraged, or downhearted. If you have an ache or a pain, you can put your hand on that and pray, but many or perhaps most of our battles are from unseen sources where the devil, the adversary, is trying to take advantage of you, of me and make us feel downhearted or weary, or like it is not worth it all. The adversary does not like us to reveal this, but wants us to keep it a secret so that we think troubles are from this one or that one or someone else. But many of our problems are simply from the devil and his angels who roam the heavenly area above us. Of course, Satan does not want us to know how to conquer this.

In the book of Daniel, we are given the most clear and prophetic words of any prophet. This is the only book which carries us from the Old Testament to the New Testament in sequence. He gets a little honor, but not the honor that he should. For example, in the second chapter of Daniel, he is allowed to see the four empires...Babylon, Media Persia and Greece and Rome. They are pictured there as a head of gold, a chest of silver, thighs of brass, legs of iron and toes mixed with iron and clay. In the seventh chapter of Daniel, we see the actual nature of these empires. The gold is turned to a lion; the chest of silver is turned to a bear; those thighs of brass are turned into a leopard - probably one of the most deceitful animals that ever lived; those legs of iron are turned into a terrible beast. That is the empire you and I are in today - the Roman Empire.

Then he had a third vision. This man prayed. He wanted to know what he could tell Israel and also anyone who would read this book about the future. In the eighth chapter of Daniel are just two empires. He was already in the Babylonian empire. He knew what that was like. This time he saw Media Persia as a ram that just crushed everything. Greece was pictured as a he-goat that conquered Media Persia. Now, the beautiful thing about these visions is that history proves that there was a Nebuchadnezzar that took Judah captive in 605. Daniel was one of those captives. Shadrach, Meshech, Abednego were also in that captivity. We talk about 588. That was the last captivity. That was the end

of Jewish rule. Daniel wanted to know if the Jews would ever rule again. He sought God, prayed, and fasted. So in the tenth chapter, he had the fourth vision. It was probably the most important vision. It deals with that unseen world above us. That is where Satan and his angels rule. God is way up above that, but His angels are also above there to help you and me fight the devil.

Look at Revelation 12 verse 7. Remember this especially when you get sad, discouraged or bewildered. If we know how to combat this, we will have a much better Christian life. The poor sinner does not know how to fight this. If he gets hurt, he gets mad. If he gets angry with someone, he may take a stick or a club and murder him. But a child of God, unless he knows how to fight these devils, may say things he should not say - he might listen to things he should not listen to. That is the way the devil fights us. A lot of people get discouraged because they don't know when to stop talking. You and I are human; we want our way. That is human nature. "And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels fought against the dragon and his angels." That is right above us. Right now. This is going on. Praise will drive the devil away. When you feel the worst, you should raise your hands and say, "God, you know all about me. You are my Friend. You stick closer than a brother".

Daniel, in this tenth chapter, was praying for God to show him what would happen to His people, Israel. The devil and his angels did not want, not only Daniel not to know, but he did not want us to know, because Israel is God's timeclock. This is maybe difficult to understand but it is also a marvelous encouragement! Daniel prayed twenty-one days - three weeks - for God to show him what would happen in the future. He knew that Israel being captive to Babylon would not be the end of Israel. But there was no answer. He prayed...no answer. One week...no answer. Two weeks...no answer. But on the twenty-first day, God sent an angel to Daniel and told him that his prayer was heard on the very first day! But there was an evil angel called the Prince of Persia, the leader of all those devil's angels for Persia, that hindered him. He stopped the answered prayer. The Bible says that God cannot be tempted, neither does He tempt any man. Then how are we tempted? That is why we need to come to church and read our Bible. Here is what happens. God allows temptation to come to us to purify us. When we got the Holy Ghost, our spirit and souls were pure, but not our flesh. He did not give us a glorified body. He

let us speak with tongues and feel that marvelous presence of God, but our bodies must be perfected. This is still going on in all of us. He allows that. He does not want us to be lost and lose our souls but He does know how much we can stand to be made better. I Corinthians 10:13 - "He will not allow us to be tempted above that which we are able but with that temptation will make a way of escape". You may not think you can make it because of your temptation. Write this scripture on your heart! Pick up your Bible and say, "Lord I have this trial or test, but I know you know I can stand it or you would never have allowed it to happen!" We have doubts - that is the devil's chief weapon. He puts those doubts in our minds. God gives us power to resist the devil. "Resist the devil and he will flee from you." You are not just some poor little individual that God has forgotten and doesn't care for because He has so many other people to take care of. No sir! Every one of us is precious in the sight of God. He has your name written on the book of life. He has angels - heavenly angels - to fight for you.

The devil magnifies all of our troubles. That is his business. He hasn't got a good thought in his whole brain. He hates me for preaching like this. But God is our Friend and He knows Satan for He cast him out of Heaven. But he still roams. You ask me where. I don't know but it is someplace between here and the highest heaven. His angels are there and God's angels are there and there is war going on. Grenada and Lebanon are earthly wars, but the most terrible war is going on right above us. If a sermon is preached, or a special song is sung, he says, "That's good, BUT...BUT..." You and I are in a marvelous family. This family is a warring family...a war against the devil.

Look at Daniel 10:11 - "He said unto me, Lo, Daniel (this is the good angel) and greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak. Stand upright, for unto thee am I now sent". Look at verse twelve. "Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand your prayer...I heard these words." From the first day. You and I have requests. We raise our hand or name what the need is. That probably is not the first time. Maybe you have prayed a week, a month, God knows how long. But what Daniel is trying to tell us is that if it is a week, ten days, a month, God heard you the very first day! Here is what happened. This prince of Persia - hell's angel (Satan has his

kingdom organized) was a special angel against Persia. There is a special angel against the United States, against England, etc. God also has His kingdom organized. There is an angel up there to help you. "I sent Michael, one of the chief princes (of God's organized kingdom) and I remained there with the prince of Persia." In the twentieth verse, "Knowest thou wherefore I come. Now will I return to fight with the Prince of Persia."

I think this is a marvelous chapter. To think that God not only saved us from tobacco, alcohol, lying, cheating and cursing, but He also has provided protection for us. If we only could see with our own eyes that struggle that God and His angels are having for our good, for our salvation and for our eternal happiness. If we could actually see that, we would be almost wild with happiness.

There are ways to fight that devil. Please turn to Luke 22:31. If God cannot be tempted and He tempts no man, why are we tempted? The Lord said to Simon, "Simon, behold Satan has desired to have you that he may sift you as wheat and I have prayed for thee that thy faith fail not. And when thou art converted, strengthen the brethren". Here was a marvelous man. But he had some weaknesses in his temperament. God said, "I will have to sift you a little bit, Peter, to get that out of you". And He did. He made Peter a marvelous saint.

The devil's best weapon is not sickness. It is filling our thoughts with doubts. He tried that on Eve when he said - "Hath God said?" He filled her mind with doubts. That is his best weapon. You try to do something for God and he will tell you you cannot do it. Let someone else do it. At the altar when you seek for the Holy Ghost, that is where you really meet the devil. You pray; you are doing your best, but he almost throws the words back in your mouth. But when you say in your heart, "No matter how I feel, no matter if someone comes to pray with me or not, tonight I will get that mighty Holy Ghost no matter what!", you probably will get it before you get to the altar. Most of your prayers, my prayers, when I was seeking God were doubts that I was trying to overcome. "You can't get the Holy Ghost. These people are fanatics. They are beside themselves. Nobody's going to honor you for this religion. You have a place to go in this world! Why don't you quit praying?" And he is still telling all of us to quit praying. He hates it when we pray. God loves it when we pray!
